CITY OF AMES 2023 BENEFITS

VACATION

All full-time employees will accrue 40 hours of vacation time for employment beginning at years 1 through 5; 80 hours of vacation for years 6 through 10 of employment; and 120 hours of vacation after 10 years of employment.

SICK LEAVE

All full-time employees must be employed 90 days before sick leave is granted. Sick leave will accrue per year according to lengths of employment.

90 days to 1 year 40 hours

1 year to 5 years 80 hours

5 years and on 120 hours

HOLIDAYS

The Mayor and City Council Members adopted the Liberty County 2023 Holiday Schedule, as approved by Commissioners Court. (See Attached Schedule)

EMERGENCY LEAVE

Emergency leave will accrue in the amount of three days per year. These leave days may be used in the event of illness or death of an immediate member of the family. "Immediate member" shall include mother, father, spouse, child, sibling, and grandparents. Emergency leave not taken in the year following accrual is forfeited.
